However, old man winter will make many attempts to keep holding on to prevent all of this from occurring. It kind of reminds me

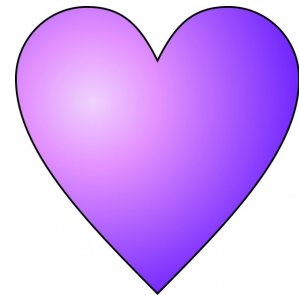
about how the scribes, the Pharisees, the Sadducees and the devil tried to prevent Jesus from fulfilling God's plan...BUT...they couldn't!!!
